



Draw a picture using shapes.



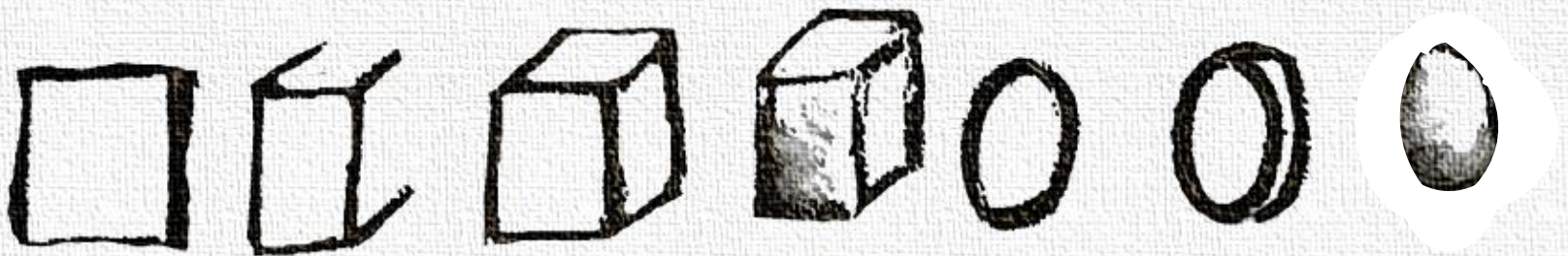


**What shape is a

Form is the three dimensional shape of an object, width, height, and depth. Draw a square shape. This is how to form a square. Add light and dark to add depth. Try other shapes.

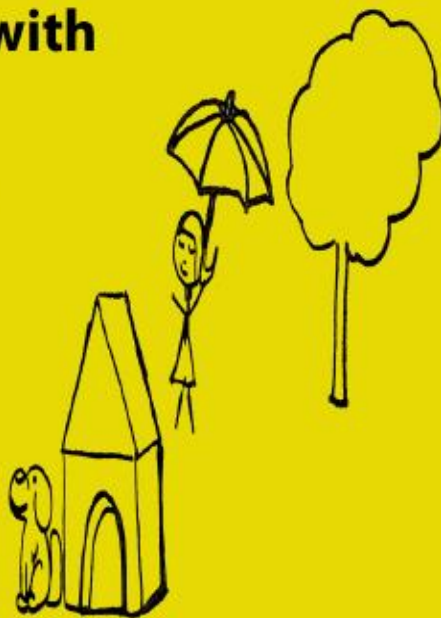

On a colored paper draw a picture with a black crayon.

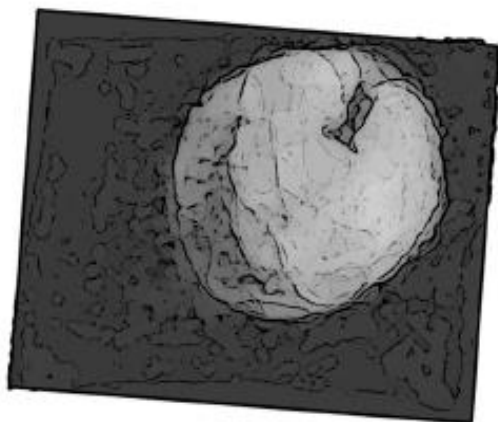


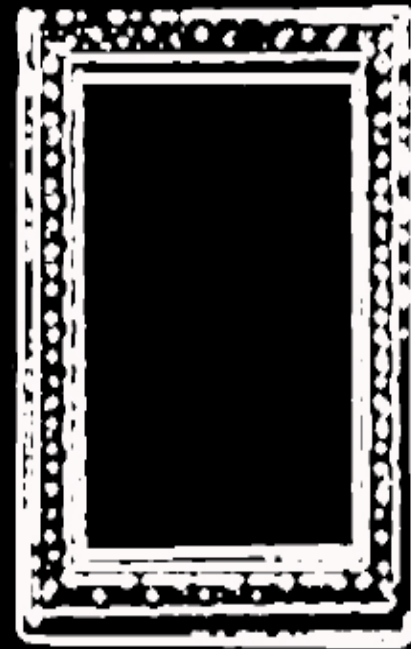
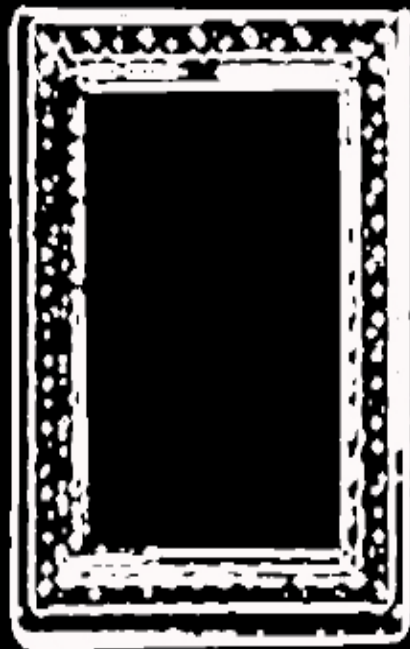
Add to your drawing with a white crayon where light is and with a black crayon where dark is.

**Sometimes the light and
the dark make shadows.**

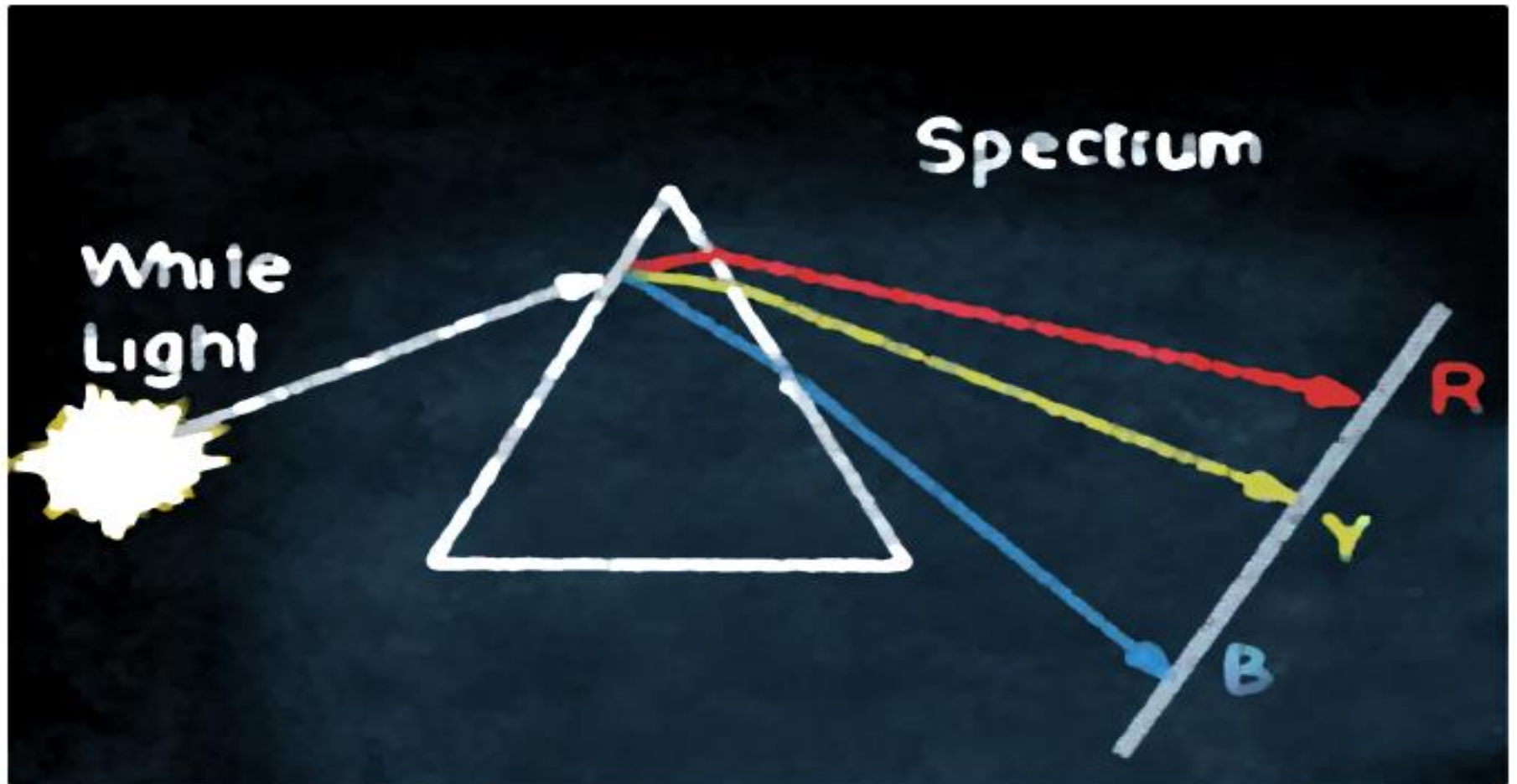
Create a shaded rectangle by starting with very dark black. Using less pressure, make the black lighter and lighter until it is white again.



Shadows are created when light is shaded. Shade or shadow is the darker area that appears on the side of an object away from the source of light. Draw a source of light, the sun or a light bulb, and draw objects that are shaded and have shadows.



God seperated light into colors.



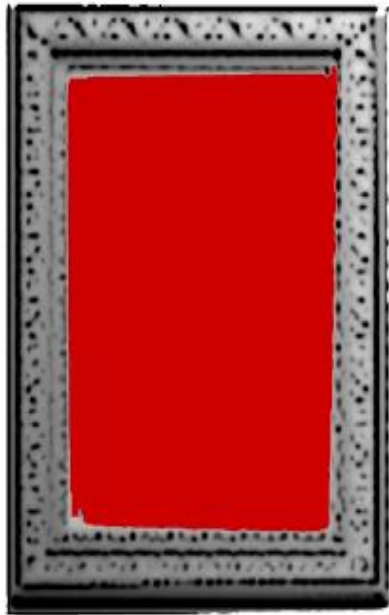
Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, and Purple are just some of the colors in the visible spectrum

Visible Spectrum

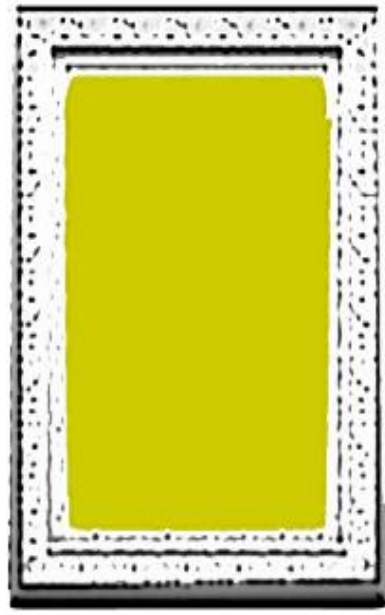
With just three colors we can create every color in the rainbow. We call these different shades of color, hue.

the colors we see?**

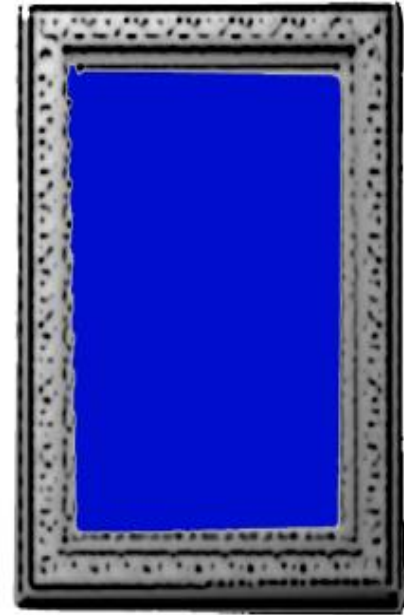




Red

These are the Primary Colors. Red can mix with Yellow. Do you know what color that makes? Yellow can mix with Blue or Blue can mix with Red. Do you know what colors they would make? These colors are called a Spectrum.

The three primary colors are red, yellow and blue. Draw a picture using only primary colors. What colors would you get if you mixed them? When you add light or dark it changes the tone of the color. Tone is the overall lightness or darkness in a color. What happens when you add white to a primary color? Black?

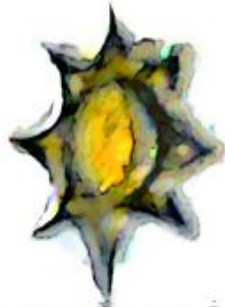


Make a color bar or a color wheel. Red; mix red and yellow to make orange. Yellow; mix yellow and blue to make green. Blue; mix blue and red to make violet.
